
- New members Wes Novack and Amy Sandgren were introduced to the council.

- Meeting schedule set for a.m. the 1st Wednesday of each month, with no meeting in December
- Reviewed Dynamic Indicators of Basic Literacy Skills (DIBELS) and Reading Inventory (RI) data
 - Kindergarten scored better than years past with 80% meeting the benchmark for initial sound fluency which is an important precursor to fluent and accurate reading in subsequent grades
 - 4th and 5th grades scored less well than in years past with respectively 44% and 41% students scoring at or above benchmark level
