Agenda items:

- Membership & Training
 - Today is last regular training 10:00 am and 5:30 for 101 / 6:30 for recurring training. The district would like all to attend. Make up dates are posted.
- Bond Information
 - Bond information was presented to the group. Bond is as proposed is tax natural, meaning as older Jordan District bonds expire they will be replaced with the new. More can be found on line (<https://bond.canyonsdistrict.org/>)
- School Data
 - Amber shared DIBELs data and Hollie had prepared information about SAGE data.
- Digital Citizenship
 - Victoria Llongo shared the district and school's plan for Digital Safety.
- CSIP
 - School goal is focused on language arts and reading fluency.
- Solicit feedback about our new expectations and kindness theme
- Back to School Night info: (Parents were asked the following questions)
 - I'm pleased with how much my child is learning.
 - I'm pleased with how the school supports the emotional well-being of my child.

- The school keeps me informed with what I need to know about my child.

Feedback has been coming back on these questions and evaluated to see if changes could be made.

- Vote was held to adjust the money allocated for aides to help with work completion and behavior to fund software for intervention programs in math and reading: Lexia (reading) and Dreambox (math).
 - We lost the grant funding for Lexia because we didn't reach fidelity minutes of program use. Reading Plus is allowing us to use it free of charge this year.
 - The district provided each school with a Behavior Assistant, which is filling the need for the aide to help with work completion and behavior.
- Cell Tower Money
 - Approved motion to use the allocated \$2,683.32 as follows;
 - i. Approximately \$2,000 for faculty team building. This would include faculty shirts and provide lunch at a faculty meeting.
 - ii. Approximately \$500 would be used to replace supplies needed in the Kindergarten classes. Many of the supplies used in past years were provided or owned by the previous teachers. With two new Kindergarten teachers this year supplies are desperately needed.
 - iii. Approximately \$200 for Positive Behavior Interventions and Support (PBIS) for rewards for students, small trinket type prizes for positive behavior. An example is the "Trip to the Principal".

Ms. Fielding will adjust minor funds to balance the line item.

- School happenings
 - New Kindergarten Teacher
 - i. Vicky Wall – First day this week. Very positive and appears to be a nice fit for Silver Mesa
 - Halloween Parade
 - i. Parade and party will be in the afternoon again. This seems to work well with classroom plans and keeping the children focused.
 - Kindness Theme
 - i. High Five rules have been replaced with Eagle Expectations this year. The spin is due to the mindset that good behavior and manners are not "rules".
 - ii. Skill streaming: Social Skills are taught each month. Beads are being used to pass off learning the skills.

- iii. Buddy bench is in place and working, funding only allowed for one bench however a curb has been painted to be similar in intent on the upper grade playground.
- Behavior Assistants
 - i. Two part time assistants have been brought on to help with positive behavior and modeling. Think time has been eliminated with an effort toward positive guidance.
