### **Mark Your Calendar: Kindergarten Entry and Exit Profile (KEEP)**

During Utah's 2017 General Legislative Session, funding was provided to support the development and implementation of a common metric to evaluate the entry and exit performance levels of Utah's kindergarten students. The Utah State Board of Education, in conjunction with a multitude of stakeholders, developed the Kindergarten Entry and Exit Profile (KEEP) to measure the key literacy, numeracy, and social-emotional skills essential for academic success in school.

The Utah State Board of Education requires that the KEEP be administered at the beginning and end of each year. Your student was administered the KEEP entry assessment during August 23-25, 2017 and will be administered the KEEP exit assessment during June 4-7, 2018.

**Friday, June 1:** Last official day for kindergarten student instruction  
1- 5- graders will continue daily instruction through Thursday, June 7, 2018.  
**June 4-7:** KEEP Individual Assessment appointments  
Parents will sign up for a 20/30-minute appointment through the Online Scheduler.
