It is not required to buy these items. The fourth grade teachers will supply students with the items if needed. We are asking for specific colors of notebooks and folders as each color will be for a specific subject.

Here is a list of supplies that will help us get started this year. As you are doing your school shopping please keep in mind that our tote trays are small and there is **NOT** room for large binders or Trapper Keepers, nor are they needed. Please only bring **black** expo markers as the colored markers stain whiteboards.

No Clorox/Lysol wipes or hand sanitizer – the district will provide each class with cleaning materials. **Please make sure each item is labeled with your child's name.**
