1. Approve last month’s minutes and review action items

2. TSSP / Landtrust for 2020-21 (Teacher Student Success Plan - Previously CSIP)
 Maintain goal for ELA at 83%, maintain math goal at 80%, Climate and Culture goal to implement morning meetings.

Landtrust-

Preliminary budget \$79,594 (dependent on actual student enrolment at the beginning of year)

- Aides- to support math, reading and behavior- (\$64,000)
- Substitutes for teacher professional development (PD)- (\$4,000)
- Stipends (off contract hours PD, registration costs see report).
- On-line programs Dreambox, Reading Plus, Lexia (budget amount wouldn’t cover all but intended to cover what we are not able to get grants for.
- If excess funds are available they will be used on technology items (replacement Chromebooks, headphones, keyboards, or other technology needs) – (\$8,500).

TSSP-

Preliminary budget \$66,887 assumes same funding amount as 2019/2020

- Aides- to support math, reading and behavior- (\$18,887)
- Full time emotional support (SEL). To include a FT social worker to accompany FT school psychologist. District funds 1.5 FTE, funds to cover additional 0.5 FTE. – (\$45,000)
- Additional funds to supplement behavior assistant hours to include Friday.
- Any additional funding will go towards:
 - i. Funding for teachers- occasionally the formula yields a 0.5 FTE due to student load, for example if a smaller class of English only 4th and 2nd grades were to happen the formula would yield a 1.5 FTE that needs to be funded to 2 FTE to support two classrooms.
 - ii. Technology- Hardware, software, other needs for student enhancement.
