**Agenda items:**

- 1- Review and Approve October Minutes--completed
- 2- Review follow up items from October—Still waiting on district decision for Second Step curriculum. It is in our TSSP plan and will have to be amended if the district decides to stop using the curriculum.
- 3- School safety discussion and report:

We discussed what our biggest safety concern was for Silver Mesa. Last year we had chosen emergency procedures and Covid 19 procedures as our safety concern. This year it was decided to come back to our parking lot, drop-off, and pick-up lanes as our safety concern. Because we have new families each year, this is something that will always need to be revisited and emphasized. Next month the finalized safety plan will be presented.

- 4- Update on school goals:

The Building Leadership Team had determined what they felt were reasonable goals for our school plan. We will be moving from a straight proficiency goal in reading to a proficiency and/or growth goal. We are thinking about 80-85% of students will either be proficient or will make typical or atypical growth as our new goal. Julie is waiting to hear back from the district to see what our growth has been in the past to ensure we are still not overshooting the mark.

- 5- School happenings

- We discussed the number of positive Covid-19 cases at our school. Currently our numbers are rising.
- Reviewed protocols if we hit 15 positive cases which puts us in Tier 3—no field trips, assemblies, or volunteers. Teachers have to make adjustments in the classroom as well.
- Content Keeper (alerts me to inappropriate searches on devices)—only had 3 instances for the whole month of October. Usually get between 3-8 per week.
